News from National Unions Africa

In West-Africa people experience partly violent unrest due to elections and political changes. Please pray for peace especially in Nigeria and Côte d'Ivoire and for the affected people. Pray also that Christians can be a witness of Jesus' love in all afflictions.

Malawi

News reached WCEU about a CE society at Dzaleka Refugee Camp in Malawi. July 2007 two women and five men started CE there. Now they are 36 (still growing) who praise God, serve their neighbor and proclaim the gospel. Tuesday is evangelistic outreach door to door; Thursday praise, prayer and worship; Sunday training for CE members, who are from different denominations. Some are new converts. If means allow they offer food and soaps to widows, orphans, prisoners, etc and additionally milk to HIV people. Their vision is to reach young men preparing and equipping them in God's ministries to serve in the camp and in their home countries Burundi, Rwanda and Dem. Rep. Congo. Due to their situation as refugee they lack relief supplies, bibles, transport and facilities. They ask to be motivated by visits and supported with goods and teaching.

I am glad to say that we, Japan CE, are all safe. It happened 2:46 p.m. 11th March. We had a severe earth-quake. When my wife Akemi and I were enjoying shopping at a supermarket in front of the Shin-Urayasu Station which is near our house, we felt the building shake heavily. We could not walk and stand. Akemi held on fast to a pillar and I went and stayed under a table. After five

The program with bible study time, more or less challenging messages and a lot of opportunities to sing had also parts where many of the local societies presented a meaningful sketch or another small program. There were games and an exhibition and the government donated a boat which is meant to make contact between the different CE societies easier. The final day saw the whole camp marching to the market place where a public rally was held inviting people to Christ.

This means it is possible to meet WCEU board members from around the world if one arrives a little earlier in Kassel. Also the Youth Conference "echt" will be on the same weekend near Kassel.

Germany

SOS Counselling Congress
"You are free too..." were the first words God directed to Adam in the Garden of Eden. With these words, revealing the Lord's positive attitude towards man, Stefan Schmid, director of the counselling ministry of the German Youth Federation for CE, opened January 22nd-23rd, 2011 the 7th SOS Congress in

Niestetal near Kassel. 260 participants from all over Germany had the opportunity to learn in some of the 34 offered seminars on various topics how to counsel better the young people in their local groups. Overbooked topics like 'Depression' or 'Healthy Self-esteem' showed what the major problems of youth in Germany are. The training opportunity was very much appreciated by those attending. January 2012 the next SOS Congress will be conducted.

Ireland

Former Presbyterian Moderator to speak at Irish Convention
The 97th Irish National Christian Endeavour Convention will be held on Friday 16th and Saturday 17th September, 2011 in Dunganon Presbyterian Church. The Convention Committee are particularly pleased that the Revd. Dr. Stafford Carson has agreed to be the main Speaker. His theme will be, "R U 4 REAL?" Twenty years ago, in 1991, Dr. Carson had fulfilled a similar role at the 77th Convention in Carnmoney.

Over the weekend all ages will be catered for with a varied and interesting programme of events. Delegates are expected from throughout Ireland and further afield.
